Monday, July 17, 2017 – Day Trip-Boeing Factory tour (Duration 4 hours). This tour includes round-trip transportation from either the Hampton Inn and Suites, The Fairfield Inn or the Holiday Inn Express plus the entrance fee for the Boeing tour. **Cost: \$45.** Modern and future aviation is what this tour is all about. You are escorted through a look at cutting-edge airline production. You will experience the largest production line in the world. Children must be 48” (122 cm) tall to attend the 90 minute factory portion of the tour. Several flights of stairs and a half mile of walking are included on the tour. Tuesday, July 18, 2017- Day Tour- Mt. Rainier (Duration 8 – 10 hours). Tour route and stops subject to park restrictions. Park Fees are included with round trip transportation. This is nature at its finest - glaciers, wildflowers, waterfalls, wildlife - the wonders of this statuesque 14,411-foot mountain. Mount Rainier is our nation's third tallest peak, but many people believe it stands alone as America's most beautiful mountain. This majestic peak has much magic to reveal. Deer, elk, birds, bear and other wildlife are often spotted. The pristine nature of the alpine wonderland is a spectacle worthy of the drive from Seattle. Bring a jacket, even in summer Paradise at an elevation of 5,400 feet can be cool and even breezy. Also, be sure to bring a sack lunch or money to purchase food at the visitor center concession.

Cost: \$65.00.Per person.

Wednesday, July 19, 2017- Road trip to Central Washington State. Depart from Seattle with stops in town of Cashmere (tour of Aplets and Cotlets candy factory). Brunch/lunch in city of Wenatchee. We will be joined by Ken Lacy who will provide a history of the geology of the area with interesting stops along the way as we travel to the town of Quincy and its Historical Society museum, including a presentation of the history of early Quincy and tour of a pioneer home and church and demos of rope making, candle making, butter churning, etc. (this tour lasts 2-3 hours). Then on to the town of Grand Coulee with more interesting stops along the way, again directed by Ken Lacy. We will spend the night in the town of Grand Coulee with a BBQ/picnic catered at a local park. Afterwards, the Dam's visitor center is open and has very interesting exhibits. For those interested, there is a laser light show on the dam at 10:00 p.m. (lasts approximately 30 minutes). For those staying at the Columbia River Inn, it is directly across the street from the Dam visitor's center and you can come and go as you please to view the after dinner activities. The Grand Coulee Lodge Motel is located about 1 ½ miles from the visitor center and the laser light show on the dam. Our bus will be your transportation between the motel and visitor center/light show.

Thursday, July 20, 2017- continuation of road trip in Central Washington State. Breakfast at a local restaurant if you are staying at the Columbia River Inn. Continental Breakfast is available at the Grand Coulee Dam Motel. We will travel to the Colville Tribal Museum in Grand Coulee (8:30 a.m. tour lasts about 1 hour). Tour of the Dam begins at 10:00 a.m. Escorted tour of the pumping plant and spill way (on top of the dam). Tour lasts about 90 minutes. On the return trip there may be time for Ken Lacy to show us other interesting geological sights. We will stop in the town of Leavenworth for lunch, shopping and exploring on your own. Arrive back in Seattle about 6:00 p.m. **Cost of 2 day tour \$85 per person for round trip transportation, BBQ/Picnic, swag bag.**

Friday, July 21, 2017- Day Trip- Museum of Flight tour Seattle. (Duration approx. 5 hours) Enjoy the wonder of flight in one of Seattle's most spectacular settings This world-renowned 15-acre campus includes over 160 air and spacecraft, the original Boeing Aircraft factory, flight simulators, and dozens of fun, interactive exhibits and family activities. Everyone will enjoy the museum's magical presentation of the worlds of flight. Step inside Air Force One, Concorde, NASA's Space Shuttle Trainer, Boeing 787 and B17F Bomber. The new aviation pavilion opened in July 2016 which increased the exhibit to twice the size.

All admission prices include tax and all groups require a minimum of 10 visitors paying in one transaction.

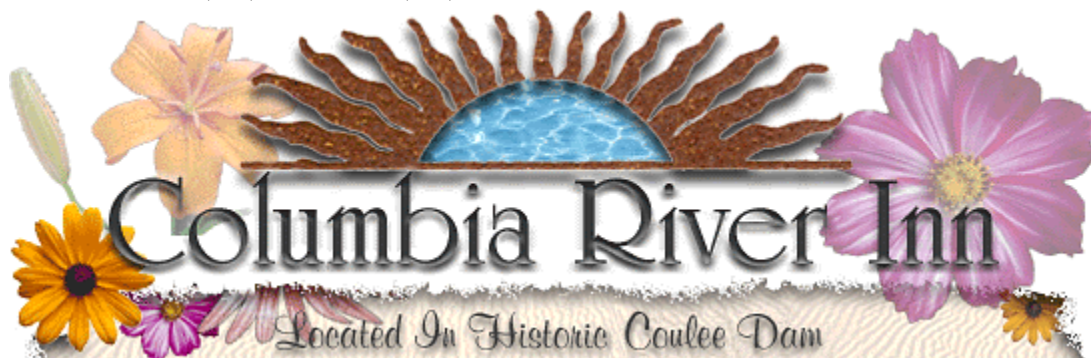
